- **3**. Requirements

(1) Regular privately financed international students

- X Students who have Japanese nationality or resident status of "permanent resident"(eijusha), "long-term resident"(teijusha), "spouse/child of a Japanese resident", or "spouse/child of a permanent resident" are NOT eligible.
 - (2) Students whose academic fees are NOT supported by MEXT, overseas government, or other organizations, and who have financial difficulties.
 - (3) Students who will be able to graduate within a regular term.
 - (4) Students who do not receive other scholarships from Waseda University

Azusa Ono Memorial Scholarship Application Guide

This scholarship is for students facing financial difficulties in pursuing their studies. 67 recipients are selected (26 undergraduate, 41 graduate students), and 400,000 yen is paid as the scholarship.

Regular privately financed international students are eligible to apply. It includes international students whose visa status is not "College Student".

However, those to whom any of the following apply are NOT eligible.

 Students who have Japanese nationality or resident status of "permanent resident" (eijusha), "long-term resident" (teijusha), "spouse/child of a Japanese resident", or "spouse/child of a permanent resident".

Students who receive another scholarship from Waseda University.

•Non-degree research students.

•Assistants or part-time instructor.

•Students who have enrolled beyond the regular course term (with the exception of those who have extended their enrollment due to illness or other unavoidable circumstances)

•Students whose academic fees are covered by organizations such as Waseda University, government, corporations, etc.

Students who are studying abroad or taking leave of absence currently.

Students must complete ALL of the following procedures.

1. Required Documents: • "Azusa Ono Memorial Scholarship Application Form" (both

sides) *prescribed form.

Copy of your bank book (the cover page and first page)
 *If your bank does not have a bank book, copy of a cash card is acceptable.

- 2. Deadline: October, 12, 17:00 (No applications will be accepted after the deadline)
- 3. Where to Submit: SPSE Office.
- 4. Registration of your bank account for the scholarship

Register your bank account information by the designated deadline through Waseda-net Portal.

- (1) Log into the MyWASEDA, and click "Change of the Basic Information" in 'My Profile' listed in the menu on the left.
- (2) Check your "Personal Account" information in the "Edit Personal Information" page.
- (3) In the rare event that your account is not registered (or is inactive, for reasons including bank or branch consolidation), please be sure to accurately register a new account (or change your account information).

*Only ordinary banks opened in Japan are acceptable.

5. Result

The result of screening will be announced by your school office at the beginning of December. The scholarship will be paid to your bank account (registered in 4) late in December.
