A successful candidate will have a rigorous training in formal, empirical, or normative methods.

Successful applicant must have a Ph.D. in political science or a cognate discipline by the date of appointment. Proficiency in Japanese is desired but not required. The initial term for the tenure-track appointment is three years, with a possible extension of two years, contingent on an interim review during the second or third year. Tenure may be granted at any time during the probationary period upon a successful tenure review.
