

Implementation of Late Offers for the English-based Degree Program AO Admission for the 2019 Second Application Period only

The School of Political Science and Economics announces implementation of late offers for applicants for AO admission for the 2019 second application period. Those who were rejected in the document screening may later be reconsidered for admission after the regular registration period, in cases where some applicants who have been admitted choose not to enroll.

1 Schedule of Late Offers

Notification period for those admitted after reconsideration (via email)	June 3 (Mon.) – July 1 (Mon.), 2019 [JST]
Registration (payment) period	5 days after the notification date

2 Procedure for Late Offers

(1) Notification Method

SPSE will send a notification email individually to those who were admitted during the period above. The email will be sent to the email address specified on the application form. Please ensure that you check your email inbox regularly during the period, including a junk mail box. The original letter of acceptance will follow by postal mail to the mailing address specified on the application form.

(2) Respond to the Notification

Please ensure that you reply to the notification email by the designated deadline, whether you accept the offer or not. You also will be required to complete the payment by the deadline specified in the email and to send the payment receipt or a copy of the screenshot showing the payment completion. Please note that a failure to respond to our offer by the deadline will be regarded as a withdrawal from the offer, and the applicant's admission will be revoked.

3 Important Notes

- (1) We will not accept any new or additional documents such as new recommendation letters, essays, certificates, updated standardized test scores, etc.
- (2) In the case that you have not heard from us by July 1, please understand that regretfully your rejection is final.
- (3) We will not know if we will be able to give late offers, or how many offers we will be able to give, until admitted students return their enrollment decisions at the end of May.
- (4) We are unable to reveal the status of any applicant for reconsideration at any point in the admission process. Any inquiry, such as the likelihood of late offer, criteria, quota, or admission status will not be answered.
- (5) Once having completed the enrollment procedures, successful applicants accepted by reconsideration will be admitted and treated under the same conditions as successful applicants accepted following the regular schedule.

4 Q & A

Q: *When will I know if I am admitted? I desperately would like to know the results as soon as possible.*

A: As stated on page 1 of this document, we will send a notification email individually only to those who have been admitted between June 3 (Mon.) and July 1 (Mon.), 2019 [JST]. Please understand we cannot tell you when in this period the notification will be sent to the applicant(s), because it depends on the situation. If you have not received any notification after the period above, please understand that you have been rejected.

Q: *If I am offered admission after the reconsideration, will I be considered for pre-enrollment scholarships?*

A: Although we cannot guarantee it, you may be considered for a scholarship.

Q: *What should I do if I receive another offer from other university in the mean time?*

A: Because we cannot provide any indication right now of whether or not you will ultimately be admitted, you may have to confirm your enrollment at another university before or during our notification period. It is ultimately your decision.
