

## Registration for Courses in the Graduate School of Political Science (As Graduate School Courses Taken in Advance)

For students of the School of Political Science and Economics who wish to advance to the Master's Program or who aspire to acquire advanced knowledge, the Graduate School of Political Science has made available some graduate school courses. If you wish to register, please follow the instructions below. Please note that some courses in the Graduate School of Political Science are combined courses with the School of Political Science and Economics (refer to Table 1, on the following page).

### **【Registration Period】**

**Spring Semester:** April 12 (Fri), April 13 (Sat) 10:00~17:00

**Fall Semester:** October 3 (Thurs), October 4 (Fri) 10:00~17:00

### **【Place for Submission】**

Office of the School of Political Science and Economics (10<sup>th</sup> floor of Building No. 3)

### **【Submission Materials】**

1. Registration Form for Graduate School Courses Taken in Advance (Designated Form)

(This form can be obtained from the office of the School of Political Science and Economics from April.)

2. A copy of the applicant's grade report (available from MyWaseda) or Academic Transcript

### **【Announcement of Registration Result】**

**Spring Semester:** April 17 (Wed) **Fall Semester :** October 8 (Tue)

**【Requirements】** Students must meet the three requirements listed below in order to take graduate courses.

- 1) Be a student in the School of Political Science and Economics in his/her 4<sup>th</sup> year or higher. (Students who have applied for graduation in three years and are in their 3<sup>rd</sup> year are also eligible.)
- 2) Have obtained at least 86 credits (80 credits for students applying for graduation in three years, and 20 credits for students who enrolled in the SPSE after graduating from a different undergraduate course).
- 3) Have no more than 40 credits to obtain in order to graduate from the undergraduate course.

### **【Notes on Taking Courses】**

- 1) If the number of students who wish to register exceeds the prescribed quota, permission to register will be decided by lottery.
- 2) Regarding combined courses with the School of Political Science and Economics, students can take them as undergraduate courses, with the credits counting towards those required for graduation from the undergraduate course. Alternatively, students can take them as Graduate School courses taken in advance and transfer the credits after they enroll in the Graduate School of Political Science. Please note that the registration method varies, depending on whether the courses are taken as undergraduate courses or graduate courses. Please also note that students are not able to register for these courses as both undergraduate and graduate courses.

a. Registering for courses in the School of Political Science and Economics, with the credits counting towards graduation from the undergraduate course.

→ Register for courses during the regular registration period according to the instructions given by the School of Political Science and Economics.

【Treatment of Credits acquired at the School of Political Science and Economics】

Credits are counted in the course category of “Political Science” or “Quantitative Approaches to Political Economics” towards the prescribed credits required for graduation from the undergraduate course.

b. Registering for courses in the Graduate School of Political Science, with the credits NOT counting towards graduation from the undergraduate course.

→ Register for courses during the registration period designated on the previous page. Submit a registration form to the office of the School of Political Science and Economics.

【Treatment of Credits after enrollment in the Graduate School of Political Science】

Courses are registered as “Graduate School Courses Taken in Advance” in the course category of “Voluntary Courses.” The credits are *not* counted towards graduation from the undergraduate course.

Credits taken as “Graduate School Courses Taken in Advance” can be transferred to the credits taken at the Graduate School of Political Science by applying for a credit transfer after enrollment in the Graduate School of Political Science. Please note that the application for the credit transfer should be made within 3 years after taking the course. If the application for credit transfer is approved, students cannot take the same course again after enrollment in the Graduate School of Political Science.

Upon transferring credits, the grade will be the same as when the credits were originally obtained and will be included in the GPA.
