

Class Absences and Absentee Examinations for Olympic and Paralympic Volunteer Activities in the AY2021 Spring Semester

The School of Political Science and Economics shall accept requests for special consideration of class absences and absentee examinations from students participating in the Games or city volunteer activities in conjunction with the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and Paralympics, in accordance with the following standards:

Eligible volunteer activities

- (1) Games volunteer activities, recruited by the Tokyo Organizing Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games
- (2) City volunteer activities, recruited at the venue for each event by the local municipality
- (3) Volunteer activities for which information is provided on Waseda University's official website in the Olympic Paralympic Project Promotion Section

Note, however, that orientation, training, and any other meetings before the actual volunteer activities are not eligible for consideration.

Request special consideration for class absences:

Submit documents that certify that you *have participated* in volunteer activities directly to the instructor of the course. The final decision on the treatment of absences shall be made by the instructor.

Apply for absentee examinations:

Submit documents proving that you *have participated* in volunteer activities to the administrative office during the application period for absentee examinations. Follow the procedures posted on the School of Political Science and Economics website during the spring semester (For Current Students > Examinations and Reports).
