

【Fall Semester AY2021】

Classrooms for discussion and joint study for Advanced Seminars

Students who are registered for an advanced seminar are allowed to use classrooms for discussion and joint study. Note that classrooms must be booked in advance and that regular classes, exams, and events organized by the university enjoy priority.

How to Book a Classroom

1. Fill out a classroom reservation form at the Office of the School of Political Science and Economics, on the 10th floor of Building 3.
2. You will need the signature of your Advanced Seminar instructor on the form.
3. You are required to submit the classroom reservation form at least a week in advance.
4. You can book up to 4 classrooms (for 4 days) on the same reservation form.

Period of Usage

October 15, 2021 – January 18, 2022

Monday to Friday: 1st period – 5th period (inclusive)

Saturday: 1st period – 4th period (inclusive)

Note 1: Classrooms cannot be booked before the above period as classroom changes of regular classes occur.

Note 2: Classrooms cannot be booked for Sundays, National Holidays, School Event Days, Examination Weeks (Weeks 15 and 16), or for university holidays.

Note 3: As explained above, regular classes, exams, and events organized by the university enjoy priority.

【Additional Remarks】

- As a general rule, your instructor should borrow the audio cabinet key from the FPSE Faculty Room on the 9th floor in Building 3.
- If your instructor is unable to do so, you can borrow the audio cabinet key on behalf of the instructor. You will be required to submit your student ID card in exchange for the key. The student must take all responsibilities to properly borrow, manage, and return the key after use. Any damage or loss of school property will be the responsibility of the borrower.
