## How to check the number of credits required/acquired for Graduation

Please carefully check the graduation requirements at your own responsibility by referring to the School Study Guide and the Grade Report screen on MyWaseda. The Administrative Office does not accept any inquiries regarding confirmation of whether or not you have met the graduation requirements.

- 1. Check the "Requirements for Graduation" page of the School Study Guide you received at the time of admission. Make sure that you have earned the credits for the required courses listed there.
- 2. In addition to your School Study Guide, click on "Credit Report" on the Grade Report screen on MyWaseda (upper right corner of the screen). If the number of credits you have counted toward graduation in "Required" in each course category is equal to or greater than the prescribed number of credits shown in the "Included", you have met the requirements for that category. Below is a rough image of the Credit Report screen.
