
Central Library

Waseda University Library is one of the most extensive private university libraries in Japan, holds over 5.95 million volumes and about 800,000 electronic resources. The library has a long history started in 1882 when the university was originally founded as Tokyo Senmon Gakko.

Waseda University Library consists of over 20 libraries including Central Library, Campus Libraries, School Libraries, and Student Reading Rooms.

WINE is the Waseda University Library's main search interface for library collections and academic resources.

It includes:

- Waseda University Library's catalog (bibliographies and library holdings).
- E-journals, E-books, and databases subscribed by Waseda University.
- Articles and book chapters (by searching within subscribed databases).
- Keio University Library's catalog (consortia member library).

◆ Search Scope / Tweak your results

When searching, you can select the scope of your search from the drop-down list on the right of the search box, such as "Library Catalog and E-Resources" or "Articles", etc.

After searching, you can narrow down your search results with "Tweak your results" such as languages or material types.

◆ Sign in / My Library

If you belong to Waseda University, please sign in to WINE.

You can:

- browse ALL results including restricted contents.
- save your search results ("My Favorites").
- view and renew the due dates of the materials you borrowed ("My Library").
- place a hold on an item or request an item.

This portal website provides an easy way to access online databases, e-journals and e-books to which Waseda University subscribes, as well as open-access e-resources.

Databases include newspaper databases (Asahi, Yomiuri, Mainichi, Nikkei, the world's major papers), article databases (Web of Science, Scopus, CiNii Articles), dictionaries, etc.

E-Journals include *Nature*, *Science* and other essential academic and professional journals published in Japan and overseas countries.

E-Books include encyclopedias, dictionaries, classic literature, academic books (eBook Collection, SpringerLink, Ebook Central, Maruzen eBook Library), etc.

HOW TO USE THE LIBRARIES & READING ROOMS

A **Student/Faculty ID card**, or **Library card** is required to enter libraries, borrow materials and use other library services. Please keep it with you at all times when you use Waseda University libraries. Some libraries have limited access policies according to user's status. BORROWING & RETURNING

◆ Borrowing

To borrow books or other materials, please visit the library where the item is located. The maximum number of items that can be borrowed depends on the user's status. Library materials are the university's property. Please treat them with respect. (Undergraduate students: 15 items / Graduate students: 30 items / Faculty/Staff: 60 items)

◆ Return Anywhere Service



PHOTOCOPY

Photocopies respecting Japanese copyright law are allowed. Self-service copy machines are available in the library. Pre-paid copy cards, 1,000 yen and 2,000 yen cards, can be purchased at the vending machines. They can be used only at Waseda University Library. We also have some coin-operated machines.

RESEARCH NAVI

Research Navigation is a guide which introduces the ways to find information you need by using books, periodicals, databases, etc. This guide is organized by material types and topics.

Material Types include: books, journals, newspapers, doctoral dissertations, master's theses, etc.

Topics include: biographies, statistics, translated works, government documents, etc.
