

Delayed Graduation

Students in the English-based Degree Program who will be enrolled for longer than the standard four-year term of study should carefully read the guidance below. If you have questions, please contact the SPSE Office for assistance.

1. Academic fees for the 2023 Spring Semester and the 2023 Fall Semester

The academic fees for *enchousei* (students who will extend their term of enrollment) are as stated below.

The “Notice of Transfer of Academic Fees” (学費等口座振替通知書) will be mailed in late June (for Spring Semester) and late November (for Fall Semester) to the person who is responsible for such payments.

Direct Debit Date **2023 Spring Semester: July 3** **2023 Fall Semester: December 1**

1) If the enrollment period (excluding a period of Leave of Absence/Study Abroad*) exceeds four years (three years for entrants by transfer admission)

* If students who study abroad at their own expense or on a Waseda University exchange program and the credits earned at the institution overseas are accredited by Waseda University, the period spent abroad is counted as part of the enrollment period and is not counted as a study-abroad period.

The total amount to be paid is calculated based on the number of credits still required for graduation at the point of completion of the previous semester. Payment of the amount per semester should be made as indicated below.

<For students who admitted in or before 2016>

*Only for students who admitted in or after 2017

If a student newly enrolling at Waseda in the 2017 academic year or afterwards studies abroad for more than one semester with one of the programs where “Registration Status” becomes “Studying Abroad” or “Registered in School”, and if he/she exceeds the prescribed number of years of enrollment, Tuition will be calculated based on the number of insufficient credits required for graduation at the point of completion of the previous semester, with the permission from the Faculty Committee. When the number of insufficient credits required for graduation is between 5 credits and 20 credits, Tuition for the first year after becoming an “*Enchousei*” will be 50% of the prescribed amount of a regular “*Enchousei*”.

(NOTE 1):

Total number of credits required for graduation *minus* Total number of credits earned towards graduation at the point of completion of the previous semester *equal* the Number of credits still required for graduation

Example 1. Where 122 credits have already been earned and 2 credits are still required for graduation:

Total number of credits (124 credits) *minus* Total number of credits earned (122 credits) at the point of completion of the previous semester *equal* the Number of insufficient credits required for graduation (2 credits)

“Tuition,” therefore, is 50% of the full amount for one semester for new fourth-year students.

Example 2. Where 124 credits have been earned, but 6 compulsory-subject credits are missing:

Total number of credits (124 credits) *minus* Total number of credits earned (124 credits) by the end of the previous semester *equal* the Number of remaining credits for course completion (0 credits [apparently]) BUT 6 compulsory-subject credits are missing.

In this case, although 124 credits have been earned, 6 compulsory-subject credits are missing, so graduation is still not possible. Those six credits must still be earned. Therefore, “Tuition” is 50% of the full amount for one semester for new fourth-year students.

(NOTE 2):

10-yen units will be rounded up or down, as appropriate to the nearest hundred-yen unit when an amount less than 100 yen occurs in calculating the tuition and other fees.

(NOTE 3):

If a student’s enrollment period exceeds four years while he/she is on a program that requires payment of academic fees to Waseda University, including overseas exchange programs, Double-Degree Programs, and the Student-Exchange Program with Doshisha University, or a student participates in one of the programs stated above after four years of enrollment at Waseda, “Tuition” will be the full amount and will not be reduced by calculating the number of insufficient credits required for graduation.

2) If the enrollment period is less than four years owing to a period of Leave of Absence/Study Abroad, the full amount of academic fees must be paid per semester. The amount prescribed for fiscal year 2023 should be paid each semester. If the number of years of enrollment exceeds 4 years, the tuition will be calculated as described in "1) If the enrollment period (excluding a period of Leave of Absence/Study Abroad*) exceeds four years (three years for entrants by transfer admission)" above.
