

Hiragana & Katakana Pre-Study for Beginners in Japanese

At Waseda University, all Japanese Language Courses are taught in Japanese, not English, even at the beginner's level. Without basic knowledge of Japanese, you may find it very difficult to follow the classes. We strongly recommend that you learn to read and write all *Hiragana & Katakana* characters before coming to Japan. Please note that it is expected to take about one month to learn them.

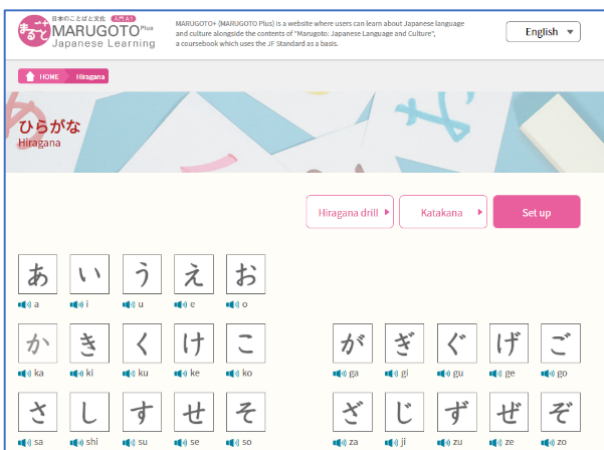

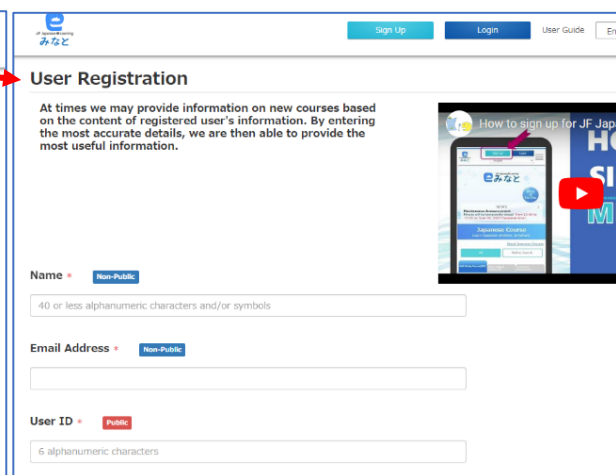
