Changes in the Standardized Test Requirements for Applicants from Canadian Education Systems: English-Based Degree Program AO Admissions (from 2027 Intake Onwards)

Beginning with the 2027 AO Admissions, the School of Political Science and Economics will no longer accept academic transcripts as standardized test results from graduates from Canadian education systems. Instead, these students will be required to submit the results of SAT or ACT scores as standardized test results.
