* Faculty of Science and Engineering decided not to allow students to take the overlapping class as same as the AY2020 for the following reasons.
①Initially scheduled online course might be conducted In-Person, depending on current circumstances and based on the student's agreement.
②We will conduct a certain number of online courses in Real-time streaming to enhance the content of the class.
* In order to allow students to participate in classes as soon as possible, if you register for courses during the 2nd and 3rd registration periods, those courses will be temporarily registered in Waseda Moodle from the day after each registration period so that you can attend the class. However, this does not mean that the courses you have applied for are guaranteed to be "registered". Please confirm the registration results of each course on the announcement day.
