- (1) Definition

The "number of credits to be earned for graduation" is based on the number calculated at the end of the previous semester.

(2) [Example 1]

If 136 credits are required for graduation and 134 credits have been earned by the end of the previous semester, 2 credits will be needed and hence 50% of tuition fees for a fourth year student needs to be paid.

(3) [Example 2]

When 136 credits are required for graduation and have already been earned but 8 credits of compulsory subjects have not yet been earned, the number of credits to be earned for graduation is counted as 0 but 50% of tuition fees for a fourth year student needs to be paid.

2. Students who took a leave of absence or studied abroad
