1. Enchousei School Expenses System

As stated on the above website, school expenses reduction under Enchousei School Expenses System is not applied to the following cases, regardless of criteria such as credit acquisition status, and the prescribed (full) amount is charged.

- (1) Period of study (excluding the period during leaves of absence and study abroad ≠period of enrollment) has not reached standard years of study.
- (2) Students are currently in study abroad term, paying school expenses to Waseda University as exchange students, double degree students, students enrolling at Doshisha University, etc: this is not the case with students studying abroad on a leave of absence.

2. How to check the number of insufficient credits

You can find how to calculate the number of insufficient credits for graduation or completion on the above-mentioned website.

Additionally, please refer to the following explanation on notes when you check the number of insufficient credits.

(2) On this page, the number of "Required" credits subtracted by the number of "Included" credits equals the number of insufficient credits.

*In the above example, the number of insufficient credits is "0" (136 "Required" credits subtracted by 136 "Included" credits).

3. Enchousei who studied abroad during period of study for one semester or more

If you studied abroad with approval of School/Graduate School as Exchange student, Double Degree student, CS program student, or student on Privately Funded Study Abroad with "Study Abroad" status, the number of insufficient credits meets the following criterion, and you were allowed to have study abroad term included in period of study, the amount of your school expenses will be 50% of the prescribed one for 1 year at most.

- For undergraduate students: between 5 and 20 credits
- For graduate students: 14 credits or less
