Please ensure that you make payment of tuition and fees within the specified period. If you do not complete your payment by the deadline, your enrollment will be withdrawn. We will not accept the payment after the deadline.

The details of how to pay the tuition fee depending on your resident status are guided below.

Reside in Japan	
<i>*If the payer resides outside Japan, the payment methods for “Reside outside Japan” is also available.</i>	
1	Download the Prescribed remittance form from an online entrance registration system, “UCARO” yourself. We will send an announce about your entrance procedure including log-in ID and password, how to use the “UCARO” around late July. You can access the “UCARO” after 28th July . Also, you can check how to use UCARO here in advance.
2	Filling out your prescribed remittance form .
3	Take it with you to the bank branch. DO NOT make remittance by ATM or by internet banking! *When you will be transferring funds over 100,000 yen through a financial institution, you will need to present documents to confirm your identity. Bring your official ID such as your Zairyu card or passport.
Note	We do not send individual receipts for your payment, and only contact you if there is a problem, such as a transaction error. Kindly check your payment status on your own, and refrain from making inquiries about it.

Reside outside Japan	
1	Confirm your payment amount at page 4, “Tuition and Fee Chart”.
2	There are 2 methods to complete your payment. Please select either online payment (credit card payment) or Telegraphic Bank Transfer. The details are below.
Note	We do not send the receipt of your payment to each of you, as we will contact you only if something is wrong such as transaction errors. Please check the payment status yourself. Don't make an inquiry on it to us.
3	Once your payment has been confirmed and your COE has been issued from the Immigration Bureau, we will send your COE. *The issuance time depends on the Immigration Bureau's decision. We also cannot answer when it will be issued.

►Using online payment service (credit card payment)

- Successful applicants or tuition payers who live outside Japan can pay tuition and fees by credit card. Please follow the steps on page 2, **Waseda University Tuition and Fee Payment by Credit Card** and access the online payment website (<https://e-shiharai.net/ecard/>) to complete the procedure.
- **Applicants must pay the commission (please check the amount in the chart on the bottom of page 2) in addition to the tuition and fee to use this online payment service.**
- Available credit cards are, VISA, MasterCard, JCB and American Express.
- You don't need to submit the copy of the “Result” page.
- Be sure to complete your payment during the payment period. The payment can be made 24 hours a day, seven days a week, including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.
- The payment can be made with a credit card of a person other than the applicant, but the applicant's information must be entered in the “Basic Information” page of the website.(Go on to the next page)

1. Top Page

Click "Entrance Fee".

2. Terms of Use and Personal Information Management

3. School Selection

Click Waseda University Tuition and Fee (special case only)

4. School Information

Read the information carefully and click "Next".

5. Category Selection

Select your choices (4 of them), fill out your payment amount and fill out your examinee number (1 alphabet and 4-digit numbers) where you need to fill out your application No. If they are ok, click "add to basket".

6. Basket Contents

Check the contents and if they are OK, click Next.

7. Basic Information

Input the applicant's basic information. Choose your credit card and click "Next".

8. Credit Card Information

Input Credit Card number (15 or 16-digits), expiration date and security code.

9. Payment Result

All of your application information is displayed. Click "Confirm" to verify.

10. Credit Card Payment Completed

Your payment has been completed.
To print a copy, go to the "Application Result page" on the e-shiharai site and input the "Receipt Number", which was given to you when your payment was completed, and your "Birth Date".

Once this process has been completed, please follow the guidelines as stated by your department/graduate school.
Any inquiries should be addressed to the administration office of your department/graduate school.

[NOTICE/FAQ]

- During the payment periods specified in the enrollment guidelines, you can make payment anytime.
Please consult the enrollment guidelines and complete payment in time for the application period.
- On the last date of the payment period, please complete the transaction by 11:00pm Japan time.
- It is possible to use a card which carries a name different from that of the applicant. However, please make sure that the information entered in the Basic Information page is the applicant's information.
- To check your application result, go to the "Application Result page" on the e-shiharai site and input the "Receipt Number" which was given when your application was completed and your "Birth Date". The result will be displayed.
- Please contact the credit card company if your card is not accepted.
- There is a fee for this payment transfer service, which applicants must pay in addition to the tuition and fee.

Payment by Telegraphic Bank Transfer

Please confirm your payment amount on page 4, "Tuition and Fee Chart" at the column of "Total of Telegraphic bank transfer payment (including the handling fee, 2,500JPY)"

If your local bank requires any additional charges or transfer fees, please note that you will be responsible for covering those costs. Overseas bank transfer goes through many relay banks so the charges and fees may be deducted accordingly. Please ensure that the final amount received is not less than the required payment. If there is any shortfall, you will be asked to cover the difference. To avoid this, kindly check with your local bank in advance regarding any applicable charges or transfer fees. Also, in order to avoid the exceeded surplus, **please tell your bank that you pay with the charge option of "Shared (SHA)."**

Overseas bank remittance Please pay the amount (pink colored part) on the chart plus the handling fee. You need to pay other bank charges and transfer fees if you are asked. This is not applied for domestic bank payment. Select "SHA (Shared)" as a Charge Option.
