

# 2026年度 早稲田大学

## 私費外国人留学生授業料減免奨学金

早稲田大学は、学業成績優秀で経済的に修学困難な私費外国人留学生を対象として、授業料減免（年間授業料の50%）を本学奨学金制度の一環として実施します。

※授業料以外の学費（実験実習料等）・諸会費は、減免対象にはなりません。

※2026年度4月入学者は本奨学金申請の対象にはなりません。

なお、この減免措置を受けようとする者は、必ず「2026年度 早稲田大学私費外国人留学生授業料減免奨学金申請書」を受け取り、申請を行わなくてはなりません。

申込みは、所属学部・大学院事務所で次のとおり手続きしてください。

申請資格：

本奨学金に申請する者で、かつ、申請時において早稲田大学の学部または大学院の修士・専門職学位および一貫制博士の正規課程に在籍し、出入国管理及び難民認定法別表第1の4に定める「留学」の在留資格を有する学業成績が優秀な私費外国人留学生であって、経済的理由により修学に困難があると認められた者。

ただし、次の各号のいずれかに該当する者は対象から除外する。

- ①国費外国人留学生制度実施要項に定める国費外国人留学生
- ②区分制博士後期課程に在籍する者
- ③一貫制博士課程の3～5年生
- ④学費免除者である助手・非常勤講師
- ⑤外国政府により派遣されている者
- ⑥企業、奨学金団体等により学費が負担されている者
- ⑦出席日数を勘案し、学業継続の意思がないと認められる者
- ⑧学業成績が不振で、成業の見込みがないと認められる者
- ⑨標準修業年限を超える者
- ⑩休学中の者（募集年度春学期休学中で秋学期より復学する者は、復学後大学が指定する所定期間内に申請することができる）
- ⑪留学中の者（申請時に日本にいる場合も、秋学期留学の場合は不可。ただし秋学期の留学が在学扱いの場合は応募可。）
- ⑫秋学期在学しない者。

# Academic Year 2026 Waseda University Partial Tuition-Waiver Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

Waseda University offers tuition reductions for the privately financed international students who are eligible for this scheme. Whether you will receive 50% annual tuition deduction will depend upon the screening based on your academic performance and financial circumstance etc.

Students who wish to receive this tuition-waiver scholarship must receive the Application Form and submit them by the deadline.

※Academic fees except tuition fee, such as entrance fee, seminar fee, membership fees and etc, are NOT waived by this scholarship.

※**April 2026 Enrollees are not eligible for application for this scholarship.**

## Eligibility:

At the time of application, applicants must be privately financed international students enrolled in a regular undergraduate or graduate school program at Waseda University with a “Student” visa status. Applicants must be students with outstanding academic performance who are acknowledged to have difficulty pursuing their studies due to economic reasons.

Note that those to whom any of the following apply are NOT eligible.

- (1) Japanese Government (MEXT: *Monbukagakusho*) Scholarship students
- (2) Doctoral course students
- (3) Students enrolled in a consistent five-year Doctoral Program(year 3-5)
- (4) Research associates
- (5) Students sponsored by foreign governments
- (6) Students whose school fees are being paid by an institution such as a corporation or scholarship foundation
- (7) Students who are regarded to lack the motivation to continue their studies, based on their attendance records
- (8) Students whose academic performance is poor and who are not expected to complete their degree
- (9) Students who have enrolled beyond the regular course term (with the exception of those who have extended their enrollment due to illness or other unavoidable circumstances)
- (10) Students on a leave of absence (Students can apply for this scholarship in fall semester if they are going to come back to school in fall semester of the year.)
- (11) Students studying outside of Japan (Students who are studying in Japan at the time of application for the scholarship but who will study abroad from the fall semester are not eligible. Application is permitted if the registration status of the fall semester is “Registered in School but Study Abroad.” )
- (12) Students who are not enrolled in the fall semester of the year.
