

## Guideline for Research Achievements/Publications Form

Please refer to the notes and standardized terms below when filling in research achievements and publications on the application form for a doctoral degree.

### 1. Categories

Fill in any research achievements and publications directly related to your degree dissertation using the following categories/genres in the following order and in date order.

- (1) Original articles in academic journals
- (2) Investigative papers for international conferences and symposiums
- (3) Investigative papers for domestic conferences and symposiums
- (4) Reviews and general remarks: commentaries for academic journals, lectures, courses, etc.
- (5) Speeches & Lectures: including those for non-investigative international conferences and symposiums, etc.
- (6) Books: Books and compilations
- (7) Other: This category includes patents directly related to the applicant's degree dissertation, articles published in periodicals, irregular publications and industry journals, as well as university bulletins, etc.

### 2. How to Cite Publications

Observe the standard method of citing publications used in academic organizations, etc., in the specialist field in question. The items to be included are listed below.

- (1) Original articles in academic journals: reviews and general remarks: author, title, name of the publication, volume/edition number, number of pages, date of publication (month and year)
- (2) Papers for international conferences, symposiums, speeches and lectures: author, title, name of the symposium (etc), location, publisher, volume/edition number, number of pages, year of publication.
- (3) Books: author, title, publisher, date of publication (year)

Note:

How to Acknowledge Collaborative work and Co-authorship:

List the names of all collaborators and co-authors in order as above. In the event that there are a large number of these however, the applicant must list at least the main author and a few others, and must indicate clearly where he or she falls in this list of authors. In case the applicant remark “○” as second author or from then on, obtain a permission letter which prove the journals are not be used for doctoral degree dissertations from co-authors and submit.

<Sample> Remark “○” for the journals which are regarded as significant contributors to your doctoral dissertation.
