- 1) **Please pick up the ticket for your Diploma of Master Degree at IPS admin office between 9:30 and 10:20 on Saturday, September 20. MUST BRING YOUR STUDENT CARD, CAMPUS CARD and Parking Permit (if you have) to receive this ticket!** After the ceremony, you will receive your Diploma of Master Degree from your professor in exchange for this ticket.

★If you are unable to attend the ceremony, please come and receive your Diploma at IPS admin office by the end of September. You MUST bring your Student Card, Campus Card, and Parking Permit (if applicable) to receive your ticket!

If you would like someone else to pick up the certificate on behalf of you, please submit Proxy Form to IPS office before you leave.

Those who fall under any of the following categories will not be able to receive their diploma. Please take prompt action.

★Behind in tuition fee payment,

⇒Please pay immediately!

***In case you have not paid, the Certificate of Graduation is NOT available.**

If you bring a receipt of payment slip after the ceremony to IPS Office,

You can obtain the Certification of Graduation the following day.

★For those who have not yet reported their career path after completion of their studies

⇒Please check the email from the Waseda University Career Center. You may log in to MyWaseda and submit your report via:

Student affairs → Career Compass → Career path report

★Holding any books from the library or IPS admin office or PC/LAN card from IT Center,

⇒Please return them immediately!

★Using campus parking,

⇒Please return the permission card.

Be Careful, if you don't return it by the commencement day, you will be charged for the next month!

★Haven't paid a rent fee for a dormitory,

⇒Please pay the fee of the last month you stay.

3) Your Certification of Graduation will be issued from September 15.

The office does not issue the certificate, so **please apply online from MyWaseda by yourself**. Using the online application, you can also receive your certificate at a convenience store or by mail (International shipping available). Please refer to the following URL.
