The submitted documents will be made publicly available for viewing in the GSSS, together with a list of the schedule of the review process.

^{*3} As a general rule, the office will accept applications for the 'Joint Seminar of Graduate Students and Academic Staff' and the 'Final Presentation before Submission' that have been submitted at least 14 days prior to the date of the event. The 'Joint Seminar of Graduate Students and Academic Staff', 'Final Presentation before Submission' and 'Dissertation Hearing' are held in order from 16:00 to 20:00 on the day of the event in principle.
