We are looking for project ideas to make better use of the common space in Building 14. Please take the opportunity to submit your ideas! We will make as many attempts as possible, and we are looking forward to hearing your ideas. There will be an opportunity to present your idea, and we will award the selected group with a prize and support you in the implementation process and realizing your idea.

Eligibility

- (i) The group must consist of at least three people from SHAGAKU (the School of Social Science) (undergraduates, postgraduates, faculty and staff). If the group is made up of students, it must include at least one student from a different year.
- (ii) Ability to commit to the project over a period of multiple years.
- (iii) Ability to give a presentation in Building 14 on the evening of 16 January 2025 (Tuesday).

What to Submit – Presentation Sheet

Present your project idea on a single A3 (420mm x 297mm) page (maximum of one page). Submit it as a PDF file (maximum size: 10MB). There are no restrictions on layout, colors, etc. There is no specified format either, but please make sure you include the following information

- (i) Project title
- (ii) Awareness of the current situation
- (iii) Project concept
- (iv) Description of the proposed ideas

*The entry form URL will be sent to those who fill out the registration form.

*An information session will be held on Thursday 19 December at 18:00 in Room 604, Building 14.

*Submitted Project Ideas will be exhibited in Building 14 during the whole of January.

*Faculty members of the School of Social Sciences will review and award the selected proposals at the presentation. The awarded groups will be supported throughout the process of implementing their ideas.
