Explanation of Events (1)~(17)

(1) CJL Level Check Test

- TAISI students must undertake Japanese Language Study as required courses totaling 20 credits. Based on the results of the CJL Level Check Test, students can choose the curriculum that exempts them from this requirement. This choice can be made at the time of course registration during the 1st semester after admission to our university. ※附属・系属校推薦制度およびグローバル入試入学者は受験の必要がありません。

(2) Curriculum Change (A curriculum to B curriculum)

- Students who already possess a Japanese language proficiency equivalent to the CJL Level Check Test level 6 or higher, are exempt from this Japanese language requirement. If you wish to change the curriculum, please notify us by email between March 1(Mon.) and March 26(Fri.)

(3) Orientation I via video

- A general outline and information about taking courses at the TAISI program will be provided as well as an explanation of how to register your new address through a video which we will send via email.

(4) Orientation II via video

- An explanation about registering for TAISI courses will be given through a video which we will send via email.
- Matters regarding curriculum, graduation requirements, course registration limits, course registration methods, and web learning system will be explained.

(5) Obtain your Waseda ID and Waseda email address

***If you fail to obtain your Waseda ID, you cannot register for courses**

- Please log into the Online Entrance Registration (<http://admission.waseda.jp/>) and click the “CHECK MY WASEDA ID” to confirm your initial Waseda ID then follow the instructions to obtain your Waseda Mail address and Waseda ID.

(6) Registration your Personal Information

- We will send you a link to register necessary information via email with other information. Please register necessary information by March 28(Sun.)

(7) 1st Course Registration

***If you do not register during this period, it might not be possible for you to register for the courses you are expected to take.**

- Please register for courses during the registration period.
- You can register for University-wide Open Courses offered by other undergraduate schools only during this period.

(8) Issuance of Student ID Card (**Only if you are able to pick up**)

***Make sure to bring either one of the followings;**

- Printed screenshot of TAO “Selection Status” page, which show your examinee number and name

 - Proof of Identification
- Your Student ID Card will be given to you personally in exchange for one of the above shown documents. No one else is permitted to collect your card on your behalf.
 - After you receive your Student ID Card, please check to see that all of the details are correct (including your name, photo and address on the back side). You will be issued a new sticker to attach to the back side of your Student ID Card annually. The same Student ID Card will remain with you for the duration of your study.

(9) Announcement of the 1st Registration Results

- The first registration results will be emailed to your Waseda email account. Please check the results carefully and attend the specified classes.

(10) Commencement of Classes

- Classes will be held through online or in the designated classrooms from April 5(Mon).
- Please attend classes that you intend to register for even if you have not registered for it yet.

(11) 2nd Course Registration

- For details, please refer to the Flow of Course Registration section of your Course Registration Guide.
- Course drop and category change (both from countable to non-countable and from non-countable to countable) are possible for courses offered by the CJL.

(12) Announcement of the 2nd Registration Results

- The second registration results will be emailed to your Waseda email account.

(13) 3rd Course Registration

- You can register for courses at other undergraduate schools (*Tagakubu Cho-ko*) only during this period.
- Course drop and category change (both from countable to non-countable and from non-countable to countable) are possible for courses offered by the CJL.
- Course drop is possible for TAISI courses and courses offered by the School of Social Sciences.
- Category change is possible for courses of other undergraduate schools and centers from countable to non-countable.

(14) Physical Examination for April Enrollees (Organizer: Health Support Center)

(15) Announcement of the 3rd Registration Results

(17) Submission due date of residence certificate (住民票)

- Go to the municipal office (*kuyakusho* or *shiyakusho*) where you live, show your residence card (在留カード), get the certificate (paper document), and submit it to the School of Social Sciences Office no later than April 16(Fri.)
