## **Graduation Ceremony at Waseda Arena (University-sponsored)**

- Doors will be opened one hour before the ceremony start. Please arrive at the venue 30 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony, as it takes time to enter.
- Only the graduating students may participate the sponsored. A simultaneous broadcast venue for parents will be set up on the Toyama Campus.
