## Change in Standardized Test Requirements for Graduates from Canadian Education Systems for TAISI AO Admission (From 2027 September Intake Onwards)

Beginning with the TAISI AO Admission for 2027 September Entry, the School of Social Sciences will no longer accept academic transcripts as standardized test results from graduates from Canadian education systems.

Instead, these students will be required to submit the results of SAT or ACT scores as standardized test results.
