**Change in Standardized Test Requirements
for Graduates from Canadian Education Systems
for TAISI AO Admission (From 2027 September Intake Onwards)**

Beginning with the TAISI AO Admission for 2027 September Entry, the School of Social Sciences will no longer accept academic transcripts as standardized test results from graduates from Canadian education systems.

Instead, these students will be required to submit the results of SAT or ACT scores as standardized test results.

Current Requirements	From 2027 Intake Onwards
<p>If you are a high school student at the time of application, your application will be screened without any standardized test.</p> <p>[British Columbia] Successful completion of Literacy Assessment and Numeracy Assessment (Students graduating from June 2018 onwards) At least five Grade 12 level courses</p> <p>[Ontario] At least six units of University Preparation (U) Courses and University/College Preparation (M) Courses taught in Grade 12</p> <p>[Prince Edward Island] At least five Grade 12 academic courses</p> <p>[Other Provinces] At least five Grade 12 level courses.</p>	<p>Submit the test results of SAT or ACT.</p> <p>*If the applicant has completed a secondary educational curriculum where provincial standardized tests (subject-based) are held (e.g., Alberta), they may submit these results as a standardized test result</p>
