1. Write a brief essay on the following question in **English**. (Suggested length: 250-300 words)

Since research paradigms guide your theory and methodology, you need to understand the concepts of epistemology and ontology in designing your research in second language acquisition (SLA). Looking at the following table, discuss how the paradigms affect theory and methodology in research, referring to a few past studies in SLA, and explain your proposed doctoral study in terms of the two paradigms (i.e., postpositivism and postmodernism).

Table (De Costa, Valmori, & Choi, 2017)

Paradigms, epistemology, and ontology

ISLA Paradigms	Epistemology (what constitutes knowledge)	Ontology (view of reality)
Postpositivist	Test hypotheses or look for cause-effect relationships in language learning	Seek an objective reality and a single truth
Postmodernist	Try to understand the experiences, abilities, perceptions, and performances of language learners	See subjective realities and multiple truths

2. Choose **2 questions** out of 4 to answer. For each question, write a thoughtful and well-developed essay in **English**. (Suggested length: 200-250 words each)

- A) Recent studies on bilingualism and bilingual education show that *translanguaging* plays important roles in the teaching of language and/or content, whereas it is generally assumed that learners require maximum exposure to a target language in order to learn it. Define *translanguaging* and discuss how language teachers should balance *translanguaging* against the maximum exposure to the language.
- B) Second language teaching in a globalized world is required to provide learners not only with a *formal knowledge* of a target language, which was characteristic of traditional English language teaching in Japan, but also with the ability to *use* the language as a tool for communication. To achieve the two goals *at the same time*, several methods and approaches have been adopted in different language programs. Discuss the ones which you think have strongly influenced language teaching in the past 20 years, including the instructional rationale behind them and their issues and limitations.
- C) Atkinson (2011) states that studies in second language acquisition (SLA) have “primarily adopted a view of learners as computational systems and of learning as information processing” (p. 18). Explain what his statement means while referring to past SLA studies and discuss a few of the alternative views of SLA.
- D) Since Munro and Derwing (1995) introduced three interrelated constructs (intelligibility, comprehensibility, accentedness), researchers in the field of second language pronunciation have measured listener understanding of L2 speakers. Elaborate on the three concepts and discuss major research findings with some issues and limitations of the constructs and research methodology.

2. For the past ten years, the writing-to-learn-approach as opposed to the learning-to-write approach has become popular in the field of L2 writing studies. This approach has intensified since *the Journal of Second Language Writing* published a Special Issue titled “Exploring L2 writing-SLA Interfaces” in 2012. Define each approach so that your readers will clearly understand major differences between the two (30-50 words each). Using one of these approaches, describe one study of your choice in two paragraphs (250-300 words per paragraph) in English. In the first paragraph, briefly explain the study’s purpose, method, results, and implications. In the second paragraph, discuss how and why this particular study contributes to knowledge building in the field of applied linguistics. The study can be an existing or imagined one.
