If you have the results, upload a PDF version of “Verification Report of China High School Academic Proficiency Test (Huikao) Results” issued in English by CHSI (学信网). Verification Report must include your legal name in alphabet and verification QR code. Only report issued by CHSI will be considered valid. Huikao results are used only for the purpose of reviewing applicants’ eligibility. Note that documents issued by CHSI (学信网) may take up to one month to be issued after application.

If you will sit/have sat for the test, you will be asked to send English version of “Verification Report of China Secondary Education Qualification Certificate (中国中等教育学历验证报告 issued in English)” (not the Huikao results) directly from CHSI (学信网) as a part of our enrollment procedures.
