

Post-graduation Plans for AY2019 Graduates

WASEDA University

For students receiving Bachelor's or Master's degrees in Sept 2019 or Mar 2020, self-reported post-graduation plans were as follows:

12,483 students graduated and 12,059 reported plans; 8,812 found employment; 2,069 enrolled for further education; 316 were preparing

for exams; and 862 reported other plans. Of those stating a desire to find employment, 94.5%(-0.8% from AY2018) found it.

MEXT guidelines for calculating Employment Rate

Employment Rate equals number Employed (A) divided by the number of Employment Seekers (B) (X100).

Employed (A)

In regular full-time employment (or with an official offer of employment), or in other employment at 30~40 hours per week for one year or more (including full-time contract employees).

Employment Seekers(B)

Employment Seekers are those who actively search during their final year of study for employment to start soon after graduation, Calculated here as the sum of Employed (A)(excludes self-employed) and Seeking Employment.
