

Post-graduation Plans for AY2021 Graduates

For students receiving Bachelor’s or Master’s degrees in Sept 2021 or Mar 2022, self-reported post-graduation plans were as follows:
11,897 students graduated and 11,580 reported plans; 8,078 found employment; 2,111 enrolled for further education; 410 were preparing for exams; and 981reported other plans. Of those stating a desire to find employment, 93.7%(+0.7% from AY2020) found it.

MEXT guidelines for calculating Employment Rate

Employment Rate equals number Employed (A) divided by the number of Employment Seekers (B) (X100).

Employed (A)

In regular full-time employment (or with an official offer of employment), or in other employment at 30~40 hours per week for one year or more (including full-time contract employees).

Employment Seekers (B)

Employment Seekers are those who actively search during their final year of study for employment to start soon after graduation. Calculated here as the sum of Employed (A) (excludes self-employed) and Seeking Employment.
