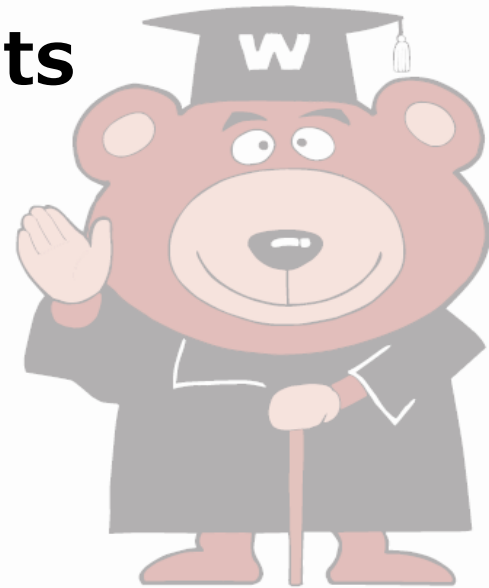

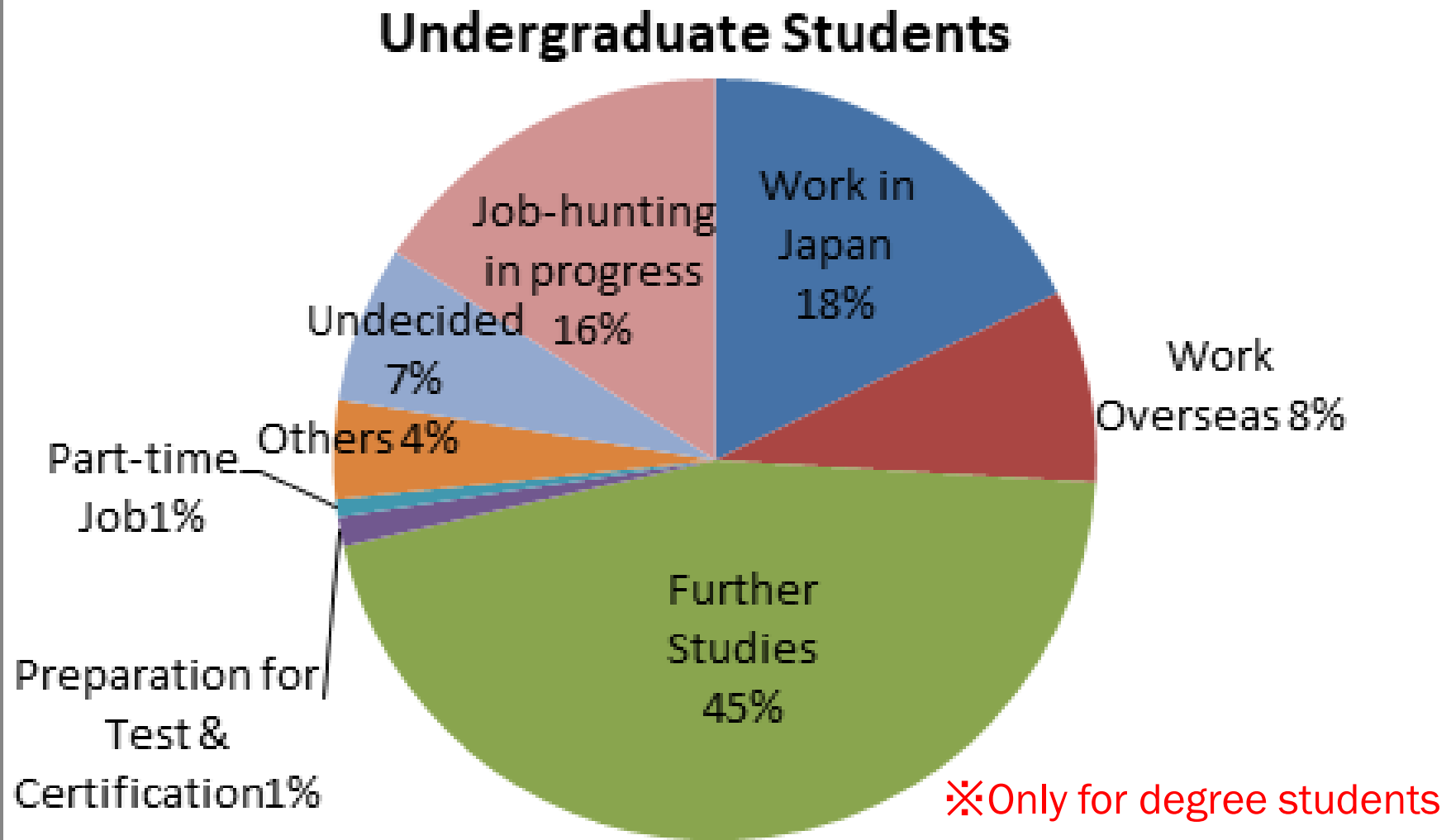

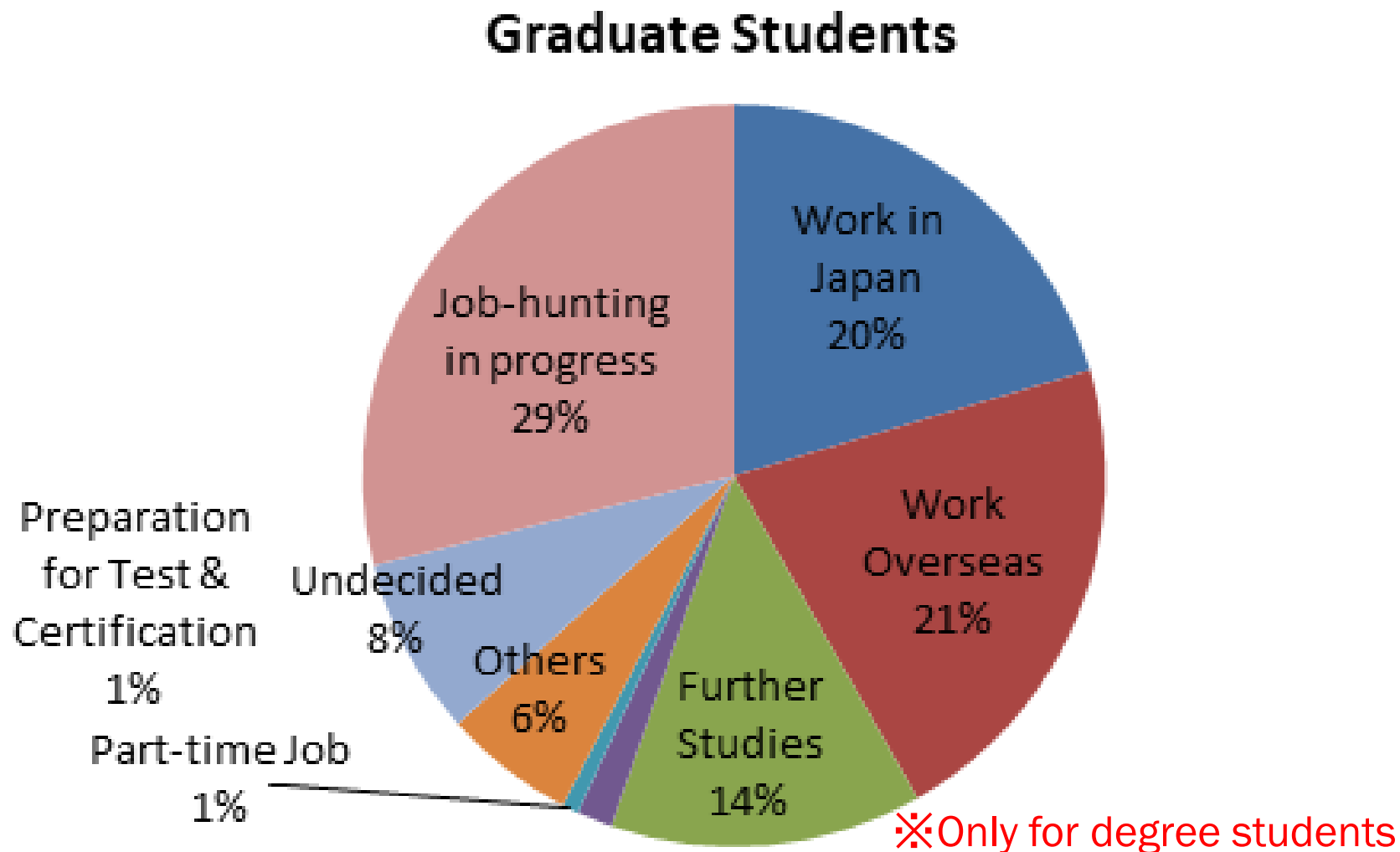


Career path data for international students

Career path data for international students



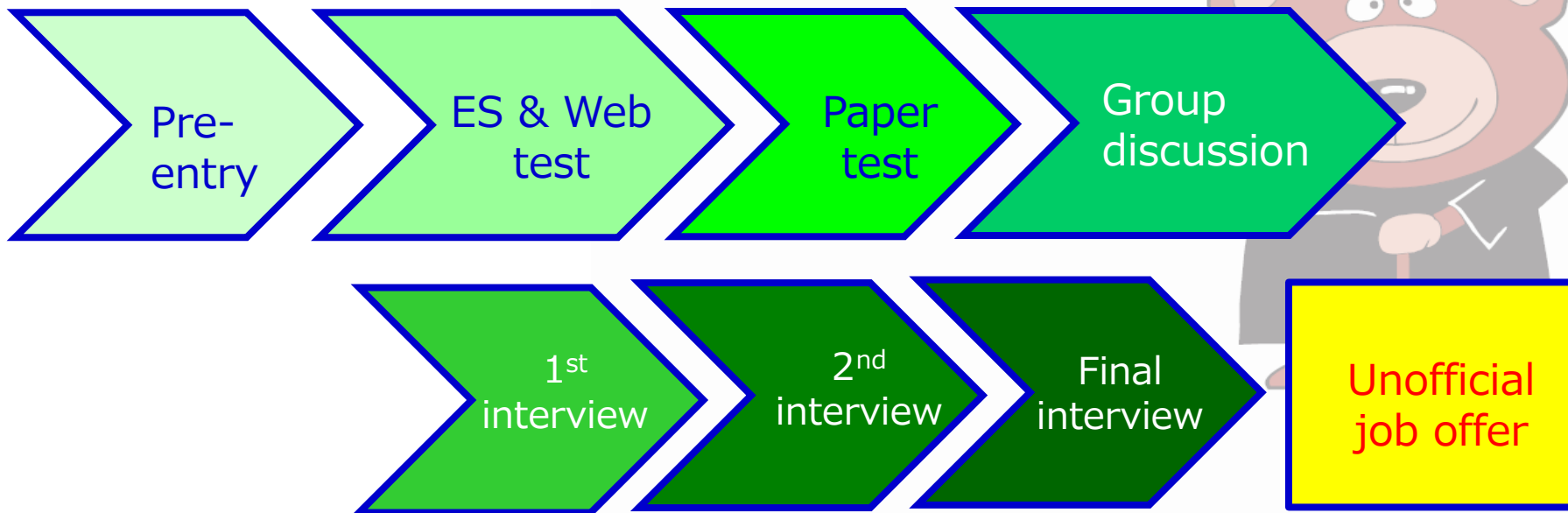

◆ General job screening steps



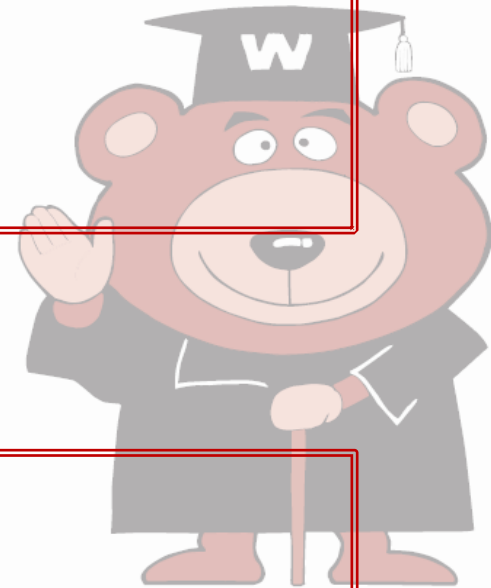
Requirement to international students



When you get a job offer

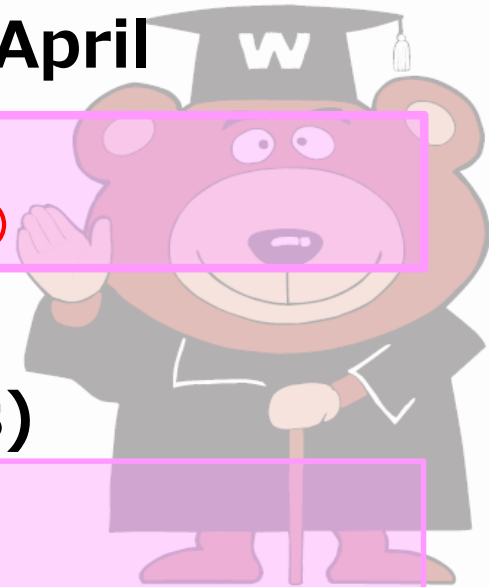
Student Visa → Working Visa

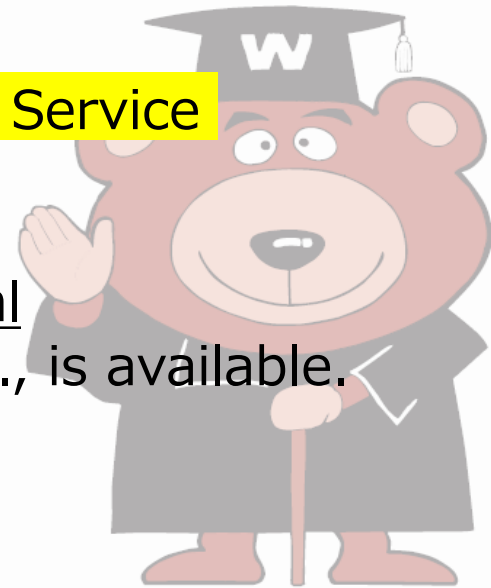

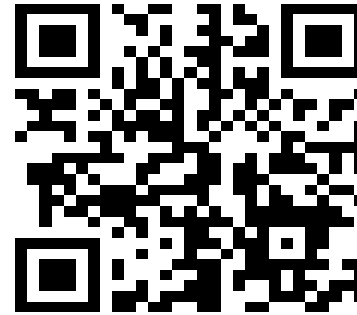

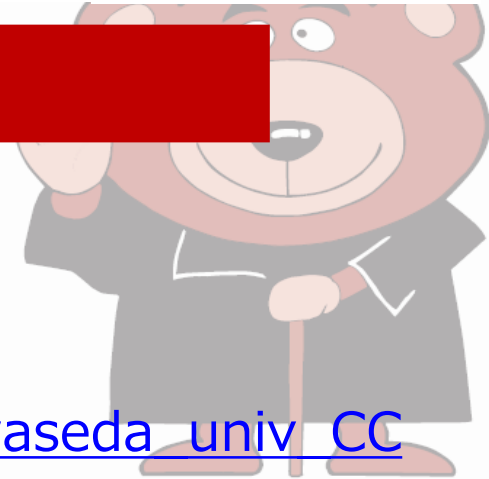
