Additional Information for Double Degree Program (Global Studies Programme, The Chinese University of Hong Kong)

Q1: Overview of the Double Degree Program

Founded in 1963, The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) is a forward-looking comprehensive research university with a global vision and a mission to combine tradition with modernity, and to bring together China and the West. CUHK teachers and students hail from all around the world. CUHK graduates are connected worldwide through an extensive alumni network. As a top university in Hong Kong and Asia, CUHK aims to nurture students with both specialized knowledge and wisdom for life. The education experience here is distinguished by a flexible credit unit system, a college system, bilingualism and multiculturalism. There are general education courses to broaden students' perspectives and develop in them the ability to face the challenges of contemporary society. Our eight Faculties offer a wide array of excellent undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

Waseda students on the Waseda-CUHK Double Degree Programme are hosted by Global Studies Programme (GLSD) (https://glsd.ssc.cuhk.edu.hk/). GLSD is an undergraduate academic programme established in 2016 aiming at nurturing future global leaders by cultivating a global mindset. It is designed to respond to the increased mobility of talents and integration of national markets, and to meet the rapidly rising demands for global leadership to negotiate international relations and geopolitics, manage parochialism and its attendant symptoms (e.g. supra-nationalism, terrorism) and react to global environmental & health challenges (e.g. pollution, HIV, SARS).

Students in GLSD are able to:

- Develop global consciousness and ability to think globally and act locally;
- Acquire multilingual and multicultural competencies and skills in managing global talents and international relations;
- Strengthen capability to apply knowledge from diverse academic disciplines to solve complex global problems; and
- Prepare for future leadership on diverse global settings.

Q2: Curricular Requirements

Waseda students who participate in this DDP will study at CUHK for 2 years. Hong Kong citizens/residents who have the right of abode/right to land in Hong Kong from Waseda will be excluded from consideration. Selected Waseda students who have completed 3 terms of studies at Waseda will be recognized as Higher Diploma holders, and those who have completed 4 terms of studies at Waseda will be recognized as Associate Degree holders. Waseda students will receive a bachelor's degree from each of CUHK and Waseda: BSSc from CUHK and BA from Waseda upon the completion of all graduation requirements of both universities.

* Please note that Only undergraduate students from SILS (the School of International Liberal Studies) are eligible to apply for this Double Degree Programme.
