Types of scholarships

Mainly there are three types of scholarships.

- Waseda University Scholarships
- Honors Scholarship offered by JASSO
- Scholarships offered by private organizations
 <u>Application Procedure</u>
 - I. Public Offering: Apply directly to the organization offering scholarship.
 - 2. University Recommendation: Submit necessary documents to the office of your school and the office will select the suitable candidates. Then the university will recommend the selected candidates to the external organization.

Eligibility

The eligibility for scholarships for international students is as follows.

 Regular students enrolled in undergraduate and graduate schools with <u>"Student" visa</u>.
 <u>Notice</u>

There are few scholarships for non-degree students to apply.

Application procedures

- Scholarship application procedures differ depending on the undergraduate/graduate school.
- In most cases, scholarship information is posted to HP or bulletin board of each school office. Some undergraduate/graduate school offices may require your scholarship registration.
- Please ask your school office for specific information.

One of the main scholarships offed by Waseda University

Waseda University Partial Tuition–Waiver Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

Eligibility

 Privately financed students enrolled in regular courses at undergraduate and graduate schools with "Student" visa

(Japanese government-financed international students, international students delegated by foreign governments, exchange students or international students delegated by corporations/organizations offering scholarships are <u>not eligible</u>.)

 Student enrolled in Doctoral course and Consistent Fiveyear Doctoral course (year 3–5) are <u>not eligible.</u> One of the main scholarships offed by Waseda University

Waseda University Partial Tuition–Waiver Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students

Stipend

Basically the tuition fee for Fall semester will be exempted.

Please note that there are only a few scholarships available for students with "Dependent (accompanied family)" visa or "Working" visa.

For visa statuses other than "Student"

- Those who are foreign nationals with visa statuses such as <u>"Permanent resident", "Long-term resident", "Spouse or child of Japanese national", "Spouse or child of permanent resident"</u> need to apply for most scholarships by following the same procedure as Japanese students do.
