

# Notice for Taking Courses Offered by Other Undergraduate Schools/Centers for CJL Students

CJL students can take the following types of courses offered by other Undergraduate Schools/Centers.

- University-wide Open Courses
- Courses offered at other undergraduate schools

## ◆ Important ◆

1) In the courses offered by other schools/centers, you will attend the class with Japanese students.

※If you do not understand what this document says, it will be difficult to keep up with the classes.

- Courses offered by other schools and centers can only be cancelled during the 3rd registration period. Some courses cannot be cancelled after the registration.

Be sure to check **全学オープン科目履修ガイド** (Japanese ONLY).

Requests to drop courses after the 3rd registration will NOT be accepted for any reason.

- If you are not confident with your Japanese ability, please make a careful decision whether to register for the courses.

2) Please download the **全学オープン科目履修ガイド** (Japanese ONLY) from the following URL and fully understand the contents.

3) Please read the contents of the course carefully on the Web syllabus in advance and think carefully before registration.

5) CJL student is regarded as a "1st year student" at Waseda University, regardless of year at your home university. Therefore, you can register for neither the courses whose eligible year is 2nd year and above nor the courses offered by Graduate Schools.

6) Maximum Number of Credits for registration

CJL students can register for the courses offered by other Undergraduate Schools /Centers **"up to 4 credits" and "up to 2 courses"** per semester.

In other words, if you register for 2 courses, it cannot be more than 4 credits; and if you register for 4 credits, it cannot be more than 2 courses. If you register for more than 2 courses (or more than 4 credits), excess courses (credits) will be cancelled randomly by the computer system.

※HOWEVER, there are particular rules in some schools, so confirm the webpage of each school carefully.

(e.g For the Regular courses offered by "School of International Liberal Studies", you can register only 1 course.)

7) Completion Requirements

**The credits of the courses of other Schools/Centers are not included in count of required credits for completion of JLP program. However, only 「日本語教育科目」 at Global Education Center are counted as the credits for the completion.**

8) Enrollment Fees

Please note that there are courses that require audit/ course enrollment fees, mainly in the courses offered by the Global Education Center.

### Registering courses offered by the School of International Liberal Studies (SILS) at the 3<sup>rd</sup> registration

- Courses available for the students from other undergraduate schools will be announced on the SILS website (<https://www.waseda.jp/fire/sils/en/students/registration/>). Please make sure to check the website prior to the registration.
  - A student can apply for one course only.** In case two or more courses are applied by a student, only one course chosen randomly by the system will be registered, and the remaining courses will be automatically canceled. Please do not register more than two courses.
  - Students need to be at second year or above to apply for an Intermediate course, and at third year or above for an Advanced courses.**
- Although submission of the English test score is not required, the courses are targeted at the students who have a minimum TOEFL ITP score of 530.
