What to do when the result ofantigen test or other tests for COVID-19 is positive

This notice is for those with relatively mild symptoms and low risk of severe illness.

1. Register as positive at Tokyo Positive Registration Center.

You can apply online (Japanese only) or over the phone (with English support). After the application, a positive diagnosis is made by a doctor based on the details of the application and the applicant is then registered.

Registrants are entitled to the following services.

- Health observation through My HER-SYS
- Delivery of groceries and pulse oximeters
- Support for medical treatment at the Tokyo Metropolitan Government's accommodation and treatment facilities.
