日本紛争予防センター(JCCP)職員(プログラム・オフィサー) 京都大学及びスウェーデンのウプサラ大学にて国際法や紛争解決、平和構築を学ぶ。2015年より防衛省にて語学専門職員として勤務。国際平和協力活動や国際緊急援助などの調整等を実施。2017年、自衛隊による南スーダンでの国際平和協力活動の連絡調整のため、5か月間首都ジュパで勤務。2018年5月より現職。南スーダン国内での多民族の平和的共存を目的とした事業の管理を主に担当。

Program officer of Japan Center for Conflict Prevention. Studied international law, conflict resolution and peacebuilding at Kyoto University and Uppsala University in Sweden. Worked as a linguistics specialist at the Ministry of Defense from 2015. Coordinated international peace cooperation and emergency aid etc. From 2017 she worked for 5 months in Juba, capital of South Sudan as a liaison for the international peace cooperation activities of the JSDF. From May 2018 she has been working at her current position. Mainly managing the projects aimed at promoting peaceful co-existence between people of opposing ethnicities within South Sudan.
