ASEP Support Staff Recruitment Guidelines

We recruit volunteers for the "Asian Students Environment Platform (ASEP)" as support staff for participants.

The main activities are support for the program implementation of students participating in each country and content planning and production.

The Asian Students Environment Platform (ASEP), funded and sponsored by the Aeon Environmental Foundation, has been held every year since 2012 with the aim of developing human resources in the environmental field who are active on the global stage. (1st time: Japan, 2nd time: Korea, 3rd time: China, 4th time: Vietnam, 5th time: Hokkaido, Japan, 6th time: Sendai, Japan, 7th time: Malaysia, 8th time: Cambodia). Every year, university students from Asian countries gather to spread their insights on environmental conservation and coexistence with nature through field trips and discussions, and while learning about the differences in the natural environment and values of each country, they discuss and make recommendations on global environmental issues. (So far, a total of 591 university students from 10 countries have participated).

This year, the 9th edition, will be held in the first online format hosted by the University of Indonesia in view of the growing impact of the new coronavirus infection worldwide. Also, from this year, the AEON TOWA Students team, which is mainly organized by Waseda University students, got involved in the planning and management of the program. Our main role is to support the students participating from each Asian country, and to produce and provide learning contents for the program, as representative of the Waseda University, co-hosting university.
