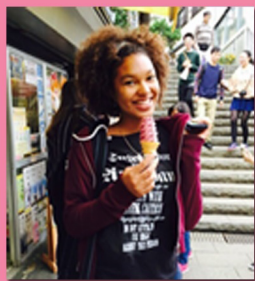


S.Y./SILS
