Positive/Empirical Analysis of Political Economy Vol.04

2020年1月に新型コロナウィルス感染症(COVID-19)の日本国内感染が初めて確認されて以降、スーパーグローバル大学創成支援事業(SGU)早稲田大学実証政治経済学拠点の活動もそれ以前とは一変した。今、当拠点の2021年度事業を締め括るにあたり、その困難な時期にあっても変わることなく拠点の活動を支えて下さった皆さまに感謝の意を表すとともに、このコロナ禍での活動を振り返る。

2020年度の正規科目は、訪問教員の来日が困難となり、取りやめとなる講義もあったが、拠点では6科目を開講した。(2020年度正規科目は256から)

2021年度は、対面とオンラインのハイブリッド方式も組み入れ、9科目を開講することができた。日本への入国が難しい外国籍教員には、海外からオンライン講義を行っていただいた。次年度も引き続き、海外の優秀な教員の招聘に努め、対面・オンライン双方で本学の学生に魅力ある授業を提供していきたい。

今年度冬学期の最後を締め括るミラノ大学のルイジ・クリーニ教授は、様々なテキストデータをもとに政党や政治家の位置推定を行い、最先端の研究を行っている気鋭の学者である。SGUの開始間もない2015年度から7年連続で、マニフェストやSNSデータをもとに計量テキスト解析の最先端のテクニックを教える「Polimetrics」の授業を担当していただいている。専門分野の実習を通して、今年も多くの学生が国際水準の分析スキルを習得した。

Since the first case of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) was confirmed in Japan in January 2020, the Top Global University (TGU) Project, Waseda University Center for Positive/Empirical Analysis of Political Economy has experienced a drastic change in its activities from those of the pre-COVID-19 era. As we conclude our 2021 annual activities, we would like to express our deep gratitude to all those who have continued to support the Center's activities throughout these difficult times, and we would like to reflect on the activities in which we engaged during the COVID-19 pandemic.

During the 2020 academic year, although some lectures were canceled due to travel restrictions, making it difficult for visiting faculty members to come to Japan, six courses were offered at Waseda University. (Click here for regular courses for 2020)

In 2021, a hybrid system composed of nine courses was introduced, where both in-person and online lessons were offered. International faculty members who had difficulty entering Japan were invited to give lectures online from their countries. In 2022, we will continue our efforts to invite excellent international faculty members and provide attractive in-person courses to our students, as much as possible, and also online.

Professor Luigi Curini from the University of Milan, who concluded the 2021 winter semester, is an energetic, passionate scholar who has been vigorously conducting cutting-edge research on estimating relative positions of political parties and politicians based on various textual data. For seven consecutive years, starting in 2015 soon after the initiation of our TGU Project, he has been teaching a polimetrics course, which uses manifestos and social network data to teach the latest techniques in quantitative text analysis. Professor Curini has been invited to teach by Professor Airo Hino from the Faculty of Political Science and Economics. Professor Hino specializes in comparative electoral studies. Since electoral systems vary greatly from country to country, he objectively analyzes and studies how an institutional environment affects voters, candidates, political parties, and the media. Professor Hino studied in the U.S. and later obtained a doctoral degree in political science from the University of Essex in the U.K. He then started his research career in Belgium and also at the University of Milan, the home institution of Professor Curini. Professor Hino and Professor Curini have conducted joint research on political parties and party systems. Upon Professor Hino's invitation, Professor Curini kindly agreed to provide a course at Waseda University as a visiting faculty member. We would like to express our sincere appreciation and gratitude to Professor Curini for his continued contributions to the activities of the TGU project since 2015.
