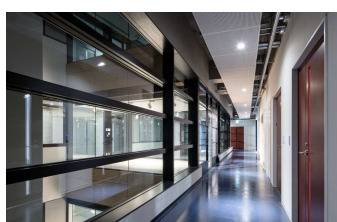
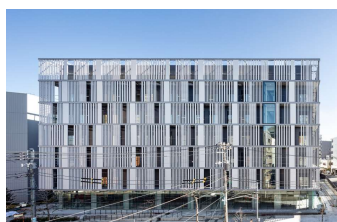


Call for Papers

Research Fields

Many fields involve empirical analyses using microeconomic techniques. Examples include labor economics, industrial organization, development economics, economics of education, health economics, public economics, consumption and investment, experimental economics, etc. Seven to eight papers are expected to be accepted.

Applicants

Graduate students, post-doctoral researchers, and other researchers on fixed-term contracts. (Domestic travel and accommodation expenses for in-person participants will be covered).

Discussion

25 minutes for the presenter, 10 minutes for the panelists, and 15 minutes for discussion by all participants. Panelists for each paper will be decided by the organizing committee. Presentations in English are welcomed.
