Title : "Best practices for writing a good research paper"





Research paper is a written account of results and conclusions drawn from our scientific work. It should be prepared in a specific way and fulfilling strict novelty, quality, originality and correctness requirements. In general the papers should follow the IMRAD scheme (Introduction, Methods, Results And Discussion). It has to be written in a concise way, using easy to understand language. There is however a long list of details which have to be taken into consideration when preparing the manuscript. This lecture will discuss in detail what are best ways to achieve the desired goal – a high standard publication all the way from the starting research concept to the final paper layout.
