

How to Use Wireless LAN (iOS)

Notice

Open Settings on Desktop.

- (1) Select Wi-Fi.
- (2) Turn Wi-Fi on.
- (3) Click blue arrow button of waseda or waseda-wpa2.

- (1) Select DHCP.
- (2) Select Off on HTTP Proxy.

Return to Wi-Fi Networks and click waseda or waseda-wpa2.

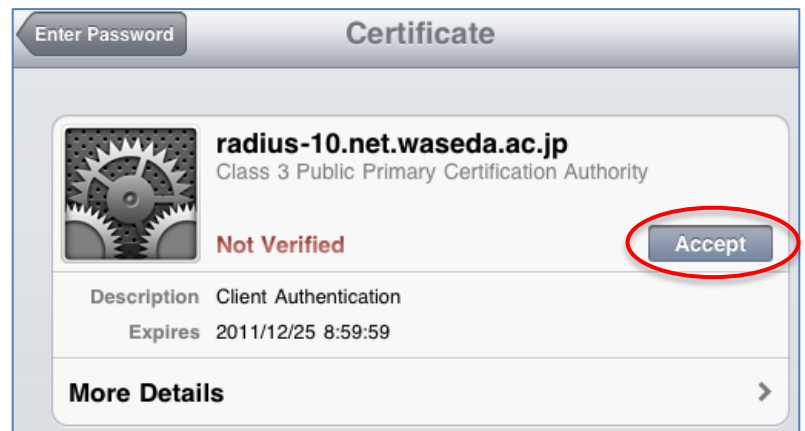
