

最後の証言——陸軍中野学校〈第一期生〉牧澤義夫氏

昨年（2016）年11月に101歳でお亡くなりになった陸軍中野学校第一期生の牧澤義夫氏に、昨年5月インタビューを行った。

本稿は、このインタビューで牧澤氏が語ったこと及びその際にいただいた牧澤氏手書き資料のコピーを基本に、同期生や同氏に関わった人たちの記録も参考に、牧澤氏の足跡をたどることにより、

- ① 後方勤務要員養成所(中野学校の前身)の入所試験、同所で行われた講義・実習、設立関係者の横顔
 - ② 卒業後配属された参謀本部第六課での工作
 - ③ 公使館外務書記生として派遣されたコロンビア、司令部情報班長として赴任した台湾での工作
 - ④ 戦犯に問われ過ぎた上海・巢鴨での日々
- 等、秘密戦士育成過程や戦争勃発・推移により当初意図された情報活動から離れてしまった活動の一端を明らかにする。

The Last Words of the 101 -year- old Warrior of Nakano School

We conducted an interview in May 2016 with Mr. Makizawa, a member of the first graduating class of Nakano School, who passed away at the age of 101 in November of that year.

By retracing the footsteps of Mr. Makizawa, this article was compiled to reveal some of training process of shadow warriors and the intelligence activities that Nakano comrades were tasked, unwillingly given in to the different direction from what was initially expected through the outbreak of the war and its passage.

1. The Training Center for Rear Duties Personnel, the precursor of Nakano School: (1) Entrance Exam (2) The classes, practices implemented (3) The profile of the persons concerned in foundation.
2. The operation by the Sixth Section of AGS, to which Mr. Makizawa was deployed after graduation.
3. The operation: (1) in Colombia as the chancellor of the Legation of Japan (2) in Taiwan, as the Intelligence Leader at HQ.
4. The days in Shanghai and the Sugamo Prison, on war-crime charges.

Mr. Makizawa's handwritten notes and the materials from my archive of the first-class

alumni and the people close to him were referred as well.
